The coronavirus emergency has changed all our lives. I had expected to be reviewing the introduction of summer bus timetables from 25 April but this has been postponed until further notice. Council meetings have been cancelled and decisions delayed. My bus journey reviews have had to cease for the time being.

Brighton & Hove bus services will be reduced from 23 March. There will be further reductions, to Sunday frequencies daily from 30 March with some extra early morning journeys to help key workers. At present there is no announcement of changes from other operators or from Brighton & Hove City Council.

For the next few months, Buswatch News will appear as and when news arises rather than monthly. Brief news items and information will be placed on our Facebook page. Bus users are recommended to check bus company websites and the Brighton & Hove City Council website for day to day information.
